Woodside Equine Clinic recommends a comprehensive equine *Wellness Program* to assure the best care for your horse. There are three levels to choose from. Should a *Wellness level* not be chosen we still recommend an annual physical examination, annual dental exam with motorized dentistry, as well as the vaccination and deworming programs listed below.
